JIM BLAYLOCK, Chief Deputy, Wood County Sheriff's Office, advised unknown white female, 30-35 years of age, light red hair, driving 1962 or 1963 brenze Cadillac sport coupe, bearing 1963 Louisiana license 941985, stopped for gasoline at Smith's Humble Service Station, Hawkins, Texas, approximately 1:30 p.m. this date. This unknown woman made three long distance telephone calls to Dallas from the service station and carried on general conversation with ROGER PACE, station attendant, and A. V. BOX, local resident, concerning shooting of OSWALD by RUBENSTEIN. She talked considerably about this shooting and remarked she knew the "SOB" was going to shoot him. She did not appear drunk but talked incessantly and then drove off toward Dallas.
