Enclosed for Dallas are three verifax copies of a newspaper article which appeared in the El Paso Herald Post.

On the basis of the enclosed newspaper account, JANET CONFORTO, aka "JADA", was located and interviewed by SA's DEAN N. RAY and EDWARD JOSEPH MURPHY on 1/3/64 at the El Paso Manor Hotel.

CONFORTO stated that she had been interviewed re JACK RUBY in New York City between 12/1/63 and 12/4/63 by SA's FNU ROGERS and FNU BEARDSLEY. She stated that she furnished all the information she possessed on RUBY to above agents at that time; much of which is contained in the enclosed newspaper account. She re-iterated on 1/3/64 that she knows of no connection between RUBY and OSWALD.
