Judge Eyes I Censor Ban

RICHMOND, July 12 (AP)

A federal judge here yester-day indicated he may abolish

the Virginia penal system ban on inmate dealings with news? men personally and through the mail.

U.S. District Court Judge of Robert R. Merhige Jr. strongly indicated at the end of a two day trial on prison censorship at that he would order a revision of the state's inmate censorship ship code.

He took the matter under the advisement but did not say possible when he would issue a ruling true.

Under present rules, prison enticensors are forbidden from a reading inmate mail going the and coming from their lawyers and the courts. The normal danapractice is to open the interpretation of the inmate to check for contraband.

However, Philip J. Hirsch. 251 kop, an American Civil Libergries Union attorney representation the inmates, charbed that mail to his organization has been opened by prison officials.
