It was not possible for me to make and keep records of all the FM files numbers I could identify. However, I do have some experiences with the 66 or as they're known "admat" files. Admat = administrative matters.

In both HQ and field offices 66 is used for elsurs and minurs. I do have records of such use for informats. Fost of the uses I have recorded pertain to the destruction of records.

If I ever bumped into 6601686 I have no recollection of it. Of the closest numbers: 66-1631 is Archival authorization for destinction;

66-1731 is items from Congressional Robert; and what is closest to your interest, 66-2554-7530 is authorization for transferring records into "JUME" files in the "Special Files Room of Records remain."

While I have no specific knowledge, I'm inclined to suspect that most of the break-in records are in the field officer, with an little an possible establishing the activity at FBIHQ.

I have no break-in records but I have a few pertaining to claurs and misure where a phoney informent number was used to mask the type of surveillance and sources. Askes some that they'd handle breaking the same way.

There is no uncutorised destruction, unless it is fairly recent, so why not ask for the request and authorization for destruction and the records cited as holding the allegedly destroyed information.

I have many references to the transfer of records to June and June Mail files but in no case that I recall was any file number provided. Thus, of course, also no serial. However, there must be some means of retrieval, a means that does not show on the Mantral Records record copy. The nest obvious is a separate index of indices to the "une records. While I have no knowledge, I'd go on the assumption that the breaking also may have been June classified. At least for request purposes.

Donald Smith in an eldtiner in FRI FOIA work. He was a supervisor there in 1976 and if my recollection is correct was used by the FII as a witness in at 0.4. 75-1996, to testify to basic procedures and backlog. The precedure then was that each request has an in-ediate rough courch made, used as the backs for initial response. Would these search records help you?

There are other catch-all files that are used like 60. These include Suboratory and research matters files.
