Dear Al,

If you want me to be able to communicate with you more rapidly please tell me ~~the~~ how.

Most of my RFK files were in dead storage. I've located them and will have my friend going through them for what may be of help to you. One of these may appear to be of value to me because I am not as close to that case. It may not be new or meaningful. On the chance it is I'll describe it and will send a copy as soon as we can locate it. It is a wire-service comment by the DA that I ~~never~~ never saw in print. As I understood it he traced the fatal shot to the Sirhan gun with ~~the~~ a non-fatal rather than a fatal shot. Putting this another way, in that interview his proof that Sirhan fired the fatal shot was that he had fired a non-fatal shot but not the fatal one. This is my recollection and I can be wrong. However, as soon as it is possible I'll send you the copy and you can decide it is of use.

On the more important item I mentioned to you I have a copy of what was my original but have not had time to look for the original. In places this copy is not clear. However, I have drafted what I plan to use from this in the addition to the book, relating it to parallel evidence in the two other cases.

I told you my means of publishing are selling rights and going into debt further. In this case the publication with which I am dealing asked for this so today I'm sending them the copy. If they go for it it can mean that I'll not have to go into debt, so it is important, very important to me. On their side it will require an exclusive. But if they go for it the time lag will be short.

I'll keep you posted.

Phil sent me several xeroxes dealing with spectros and NAAs as I'd asked him to get for you and for me. I have not had time to read them and won't until we file the appeal. If they are helpful to you I can send you other similar stuff. It is not precisely what I wanted us to have and I will continue efforts to get that once classes get organized at Maryland. I'll ask Floyd to find a student in the right school to try from the texts in that library. Phil seems to have left in a hurry.

If you want more on Belin, please call me. I've thought of more and can refer you to sources. You can have xeroxes of some of his personal dishonesties I think most people would find rather serious in a lawyer and in his repeating them in his book after he knew he was being dishonest.
