

## Black Leaders Ask to See FBI Files

PRICHARD, Ala. — The National Conference of Black Mayors, expressing a "sense of outrage" over new reports that the FBI tried to force the late Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. out of the leadership of the civil rights movement, is asking to see bureau files on black leaders.

Prichard Mayor A.J. Cooper, president of the conference, said yesterday telegrams have been sent to Attorney General Griffin Bell and FBI director William H. Webster requesting a meeting to discuss the files.
