The pilot, WILSON, continued the conversation in a serious vein as to the meaning of love, following which Dr. KING reportedly continued to laugh and joke about the incident.

[REDACTED] advised that after hearing this story related to him by his brother, who received the story from the pilot, he was of the opinion that if the incident had been sufficiently serious and if the hostess in question had told the story to her boyfriend or some other man, then the latter may have become sufficiently incensed to attempt to do violence to Dr. KING. [REDACTED] also expressed the opinion that possibly some other person aboard may have repeated this story to someone who possibly took some action to harm Dr. KING on the grounds that he had insulted a white woman.
