[REDACTED] A state liquor store is on the first floor and there are approximately four apartments on the second floor. Everyone residing in the apartments on the second floor is connected in some way with SCLC.

It is to be noted that BEVERLY STERNER [REDACTED] and BEVEL have been interviewed by agents at this address.

[REDACTED] went to the address to talk to BEVEL. [REDACTED] determine [REDACTED] any plans being made by SCLC in connection with the recent arrest of RALPH ABERNATHY in Charleston, S.C.

[REDACTED] advised that BEVEL was in New York and has been in New York for three weeks. He also stated that it would be impossible [REDACTED] to contact him at this time.

With regard to activity of SCLC in Charleston, S.C., [REDACTED] no plans have been made by SCLC in Philadelphia [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] SCLC was "apparently falling apart in Philadelphia."
