Dear Mr. Wessberg,

Thank you for your letter of 1/27 and J. McKinley. He is with Phil. D. News at the present on a trip and will be back in about a month. About S.E. I wrote to FBI and Attorney General and stopped in the office of Phila. FBI. It was a stone wall. I wrote to the Greek Consulate in Wash.; they forwarded to N.Y. consul. They wrote they never heard about. But S.E. gave references of the Greek dipl. corps. I sent a telegram to Ministry of Foreign aff. in Athin, asking to refresh the memory of their nats in the consulates; no answer.

You tell me that British sketch of the magic bullet is primitive. But it shows the absurdity of the Warren report without reading of hundreds of pages of bla-bla-bla. In what of your books you pinpoint who was at the origine of the murder? Buchanan says it clear. I am amazed that so many people who were involved in both Kennedy and King murders keep silence. It must be a very powerfull organisation behind

them. Why can you not publish
your new material in a magazine?
Not too many people buy a book.
By the way J. Anderson who likes
sensations never answered my letter
about S. E. The Post (wash.) refused
to print an add ~~was~~ in which I
was looking for a historian and gave
full name of S. E.
