

Assassination Plot

CLEVELAND—The Cleveland Plain Dealer reports that Federal authorities are investigating a plot by five men to assassinate all nine Supreme Court Justices.

The newspaper quoted sources close to a Federal grand jury as saying the five men had planned to set off explosives in the court chamber on Nov. 18. But the assassination attempt was postponed for unknown reasons.

The plot was said to involve a former Chicago police officer, a onetime Wisconsin Ku Klux Klan official, two Akron, Ohio, men and a fifth man. The Plain Dealer reported that the men were disturbed by the Court's liberal leanings.
