Klan and ex-Klan names culled from H.U.A.C. Hearings 89th Cong. 2nd Session (parts 3-5 only). Pages 2333-2663 used herein. Relates to hearings held January 1966.

Mostly Louisiana names, some Mississippi and other. Groups: United Klans of America, Realm of Louisiana (aka "Louisiana Rescue Service") - (Old) Original Knights of the K.K.K., Realm of Louisiana- and Original KuKlux Klans of America, Inc. (formed early 1965).

Note: Hearings on Klan activities were held in 1965 at Baton Rouge before the Joint Legislative Committee on Un-American activities of Louisiana. Hon. Jesse M. Knowles, Chairman; Jack N. Rogers, Committee Counsel. Additional information would be available from their transcript.
