Quoting CBS, "'Did Oswald have time to get to Tenth and Patton in time for the fatal encounter with Tippit?' I know of no responsible critic of the Commission who has raised this point, which CBS pretended was a vital argument of the critics."

This is false. I do. It is no answer to say, "Oswald had more than a halfhour to cover the distance of approximately four miles," for he had first to go to his rooming house and to be there as late as 1:03 p.m., which in itself prevented his getting to the Tippit murder scene in time to commit it.
