Jap Agent Fined, Gets Year and Day

New York, Sept. 22 (AP) — John Le Clair, former New York and New Jersey College instructor, was sentenced to a year and a day imprisonment and fined \$9000 in Federal Court today. He had pleaded guilty to an indictment charging him with acting as an unregistered paid agent of the Japanese govern-

ment. 9-23-43
The fine equaled the total received by Le Clair from the Japanese from July, 1938, until June, 1941, for articles of a pro-Japanese nature which he wrote and which were distributed to numerous American newspapers and periodicals.
