

Altgens, James W.. Test. 12:45 p.m. 7/22/64, off. US ATTY, Dallas. Vii 515-25

Mr. Liebeler. I have a picture here which has been marked as Commission Exhibit No. 203 and I ask you is that is not the first picture ~~xxxxxxx~~ that you took after you left the intersection of Main and Houston and crossed Desley Plaza and stood on the side of Elm Street accross from the Texas School Book Depository Book Building? (sic)

Mr. Altgens. Yes, sir.

Mr. Liebeler. Do you recognize that as the picture which you took?

Mr. Altgens. Yes, sir. (p 519)

Mr. Altgens. Yes; there were also a number of ~~xxx~~ people looking out of ~~o~~ I believe this building here (indicating on photograph). *WAS POSSIBLE - SEE 203*

Mr. Liebeler. Indicating the building immediately accross Houston Street from the School Book Depository? (p.523)

Exhibit 203, as reproduced in Volume 16 on page 584 is not the full Altgens picture. It does not show the building accross Houston Street. In fact, it shows even less of the right side of the full negative than even the version used in the Report - about 25% less of the right side than even that cropped version. Yet is it clear from the quoted testimony that the picture used in evidence as Exhibit No. 203 showed this building and the people looking out of windows. Hence Exhibit No. 203 as printed in Volume 16 is, in fact, not Exhibit No. 203 that was used in the taking of testimony and as the basis for testimony.

(While it shows less of the right side, it show much more of the left, more even than the copy supplied by AP It also shows less of both the top and the bottom than the version used in the Report)
