Special Agent R. A. FELTAULT, Security Office, U. S. Department of State (USDS), telephone DU 3-4000, called WFO at 9:44 p.m., 8/25/67, and advised ROBERT H. SYLVESTER, Clerk, as follows:

During the evening of 8/25/67 he interviewed one ARMAND REISER, a summer employee in the Pouch Room of USDS who terminated employment 8/25/67. REISER advised that he recently learned the following information from his girl friend, Miss ELIZABETH BESSINGER, 4120 South 31st St., Arlington, Virginia, who, in turn, learned the information from a mutual friend of herself and REISER, one MICHAEL BATIESTE, Negro male, whose address is presently known only as Arlington, Virginia.

BATIESTE has a cousin identified as Corporal THOMAS L. LINDON, U. S. Marine Corps (USMC), who is presently assigned

to Company A, Headquarters Battalion, Headquarters USMC, and is billeted at Henderson Hall barracks, Arlington, Virginia. LINDON has reportedly told BATIESTE in confidence that LINDON has access to highly classified files in connection with his USMC assignment. LINDON further told BATIESTE that in the course of reviewing these files he observed information on the assassination of President KENNEDY. According to LINDON it was documented in this file that LEE HARVEY OSWALD had nothing to do with the assassination. LINDON further stated the file also says that the assassination was a "conspiracy on the part of the government." Also, that the actual assassin was a former Secret Service agent; further, that JACK RUBY was killed by the government with some type of injection.

According to ARMAND REISER, he heard that LINDON gave this information to BATIESTE in confidence and that BATIESTE passed it on to ELIZABETH BESSINGER in confidence.

SA FELTAULT advised that he learned no further specific details from ARMAND REISER re this matter. He did determine that REISER is not aware of the actual military assignment of THOMAS L. LINDON.

SA FELTAULT said that this matter was apparently worrying REISER considerably. He first called FELTAULT re the information on 8/25/67 and then appeared personally at the Security Office, USDS, in response to the invitation of FELTAULT.

REISER terminated his employment with USDS 8/25/67. During the evening of that date he planned to catch a plane to return to college, North Central College, Naperville, Illinois. SA FELTAULT is unaware of REISER's home address.

SA FELTAULT said he reported this information to SA FERRICK, Intelligence Division, U.S. Secret Service (USSS), Washington, D. C., during the evening of 8/25/67. SA FERRICK

indicated that Secret Service would attempt to interview Corporal THOMAS L. LINDON. SA FERRICK advised SA FELTAULT that the telephone number furnished by ARMAND REISER as the residence telephone of Corporal LINDON, JA 8-0765, has been determined to be the telephone number of one ~~JULIA MOSLEY~~, 826 S. Scott Street, Arlington, Virginia.

SA FELTAULT said he was reporting this information to the FBI at the suggestion of Secret Service. He said his office has made no decision re dissemination of this information to USMC, but he will insure that USDS or USSS makes this dissemination to USMC.

on 8/29/67, Bureau liaison with U.S. Secret Service determined U.S. Secret Service will take no action regarding this matter pending Bureau inquiries.

This matter is to receive expeditious attention.

NOTE:

A Special Agent of the Security Office, U.S. Department of State, interviewed a summer employee of the Department of State who had obtained information third-hand that Corporal Thomas L. Lindon, U.S. Marine Corps had said that during the course of his duties, he had reviewed U.S. Marine Corps files and observed information concerning the assassination of President Kennedy. The files allegedly reflected that Lee Harvey Oswald had nothing to do with the assassination. Lindon further indicated that the files revealed the assassination was a "conspiracy on the part of the Government." Also the actual assassin was a former Secret Service Agent. Further, Jack Ruby was killed by the Government with some type of injection.

When all the facts are received, dissemination will be made to the Department, U.S. Secret Service, U.S. State Department and the U.S. Marine Corps.

of the Pouch Room USDS who terminated employment on August 25,  
1967. Reiser advised Special Agent Feltault that he had recently  
been told by his girl friend, Miss Elizabeth Bessinger, 4120  
South 31st Street, Arlington, Virginia who had received the  
information furnished by her from a mutual friend of herself and  
Reiser, one Michael Batieste, a Negro male, whose address is  
known only as Arlington, Virginia, the following information:

Batieste has a cousin, Corporal Thomas L. Lindon,  
United States Marine Corps (USMC) presently assigned to Company  
A, Headquarters Battalion, Headquarters, USMC and is billeted  
at Henderson Hall barracks, Arlington, Virginia. Lindon  
reportedly told Batieste in confidence that he, Lindon, has  
access to highly classified files in connection with his USMC  
assignment. Lindon further told Batieste that in the course of  
reviewing these files, he observed information relating to the

assassination of President Kennedy. According to Lindon, it was documented in this file that Lee Harvey Oswald had nothing to do with the assassination. Lindon also reportedly told Batieste that the file also shows that the assassination was a "conspiracy on the part of the Government", the actual assassin was a former Secret Service Agent and that Jack Ruby was killed by the "Government" with some type of injection. Special Agent Feltault advised that Reiser was not aware of the specific military assignment of Corporal Thomas L. Lindon. He also stated Reiser intended to return to North Central College, Naperville, Illinois the evening of August 25, 1967 and the home address of Reiser was unknown. v1

SA Feltault stated he had reported the aforementioned information to Special Agent Ferrick, Intelligence Division, United States Secret Service (USSS) the evening of August 25, 1967 and indicated that USSS would attempt to interview Lindon. He added the residence telephone number of Corporal Lindon as furnished by Reiser is JA 8-0765 which number is listed to Julia Mosley, 826 S. Scott Street, Arlington, Virginia.
