Sen. Long— FBI Knows DA Is Right

New Orleans (AP) — Sen. J. Bennett Johnston thinks the FBI knows who shot the assassination and would prove his claim if the Justice Dept. had been more forthcoming about the conspiracy.

Johnston, who was one of the few senators to get the FBI information, said he does not think the FBI information will be made available to the public in due course. He said he does not think the Warren Commission conspired to withhold anything from the public.

Johnston said that the flood of news from the light to dark, but he did not turn a report handed down by the FBI, he stated.

Johnston contends that Oswald, David W. Thorne and Clay Shaw were in the New Orleans area on Sept. 22, 1963, and were involved in an assassination attempt.

The Warren Report said Oswald was a former New Orleans resident who had been a resident and that there was no credible evidence of a conspiracy involved.
