Inspector JOE SULLIVAN telephonically contacted this office and advised that WALTER LANE BAILEY, owner of the Lorraine Motel, Memphis, Tenn., at which hotel KING was assassinated, had been contacted by some man from DA JIM GARRISON's Office in Orleans Parish for an appointment at 4 p.m., Friday, 4/12/68.

Mr. SULLIVAN inquired as to whether we had any information concerning this and I advised him we did not.

I inquired if he had the name of the person from the District Attorney's Office in Orleans Parish and Inspector SULLIVAN said he did not.

Inspector SULLIVAN advised he was notifying the Bureau immediately.
