Dear Mr. McVeigh,

Thanks for the thoughtfulness of the stamped envelope.

You have all the books I've been able to print to date. I have done two parts of two books, four books, so to speak, by file in limited, xerox editions, which are expensive and the distribution of which I restrict to prevent plagiarism and misuse.

Two, under the title LOST MONTAG, deal with the autopsy and what relates. It has an enormous amount of new information. There will be a third part, already researched. Two, under a title since stolen twice, COUP D'ETAT, deal with the two Kennedy and the King assassinations as such. It is a very, very long book, well over a third of a million words, with about 100 pages of facsimile reproduction of hitherto suppressed documents.

The second part of COUP, dealing with King/Rey only, has been condensed and will be printed commercially. I do not know when there will be copies or what they will cost.

On Joesten, in the light of what we know today, his first book, the one you read, is very irresponsible. However, for the period in which it was written it was an important book and served the necessary function of raising questions.

Since then, either Joesten was flipped or he was always a crook and irresponsible and it didn't show. His subsequent work has been a wild melding of the most open literary takevery and a sick and entirely uninhibited imagination. If I were blinded by it and heard him say the sun is shining, I'd have to ask myself, with Joesten saying it, can it be true?

His personal morals are such he culled me out of several of my books, didn't repay me in any way, and then plagiarized them - and had the gall to make other pretenses so he could come into sending them to Europe by airmail, which costs more than the books. Any more questions about Joesten?
