Not for the first time yesterday ary Mack. archivist of the Dallas County Historical foundation Sixth Floor Mus eum, said they would like to have all my records. As in the past I told him that absent a change on Hood's party all goes there and to get anything from it to get in touch with McKnight of Tharles Kuhn, the librarian.

He seems to regard as of more than usual importance all the critiques I have written and he understands that with the Archives having switched identifications to the computer it is only with a collection like mine, which is arranged by the official files numbers of this records, can they be used in conjunctions with or in examining all the books up to Newman's Oswald and the CIA.

All these wax records now have arbitrary identification numbers that do not in and of themselves correlate them with the records as they were written about in virtually all the assassination literature. And the currat work of deciding how to categorize each record is not by the Archives but by the agency of origin. For computer purposes.

Gary also told me that the WPA people who are preparing an assassination show and who interviwed me for it also put that fake TV Show on Philes out. It leads his people to be a bit leary of them now. He was taken they want to use my cleares t print of the well-known Moorman polaroid obtained from a newspicture service and a glossy print. I left that decision up to Gary and told him that whatever it is, it has my approval in advance.

They did not have a copy of the transcript of the press conference by the doctors after they cleaned up, after pronouncing the President dead. I put a copy on today's mail to him.
