Dear Gary,

You will recall some time ago you sent me a reference to a writer from outside the country, etc. Something else made me think of Buchanan and, as you'll recall from my letters to Chris, I've been seeking a book by him.

Today I had an unexpected phone call from the guy who fed us the "Mafia" tip. He says he has seen the National Inquirer, which has an assassination/New Orleans story by Buchanan in it, another to come. From the meager description, which need not be accurate, it sounds like "Farewell America Revisited".

The renewed AIC newsletter came today and I've read it. It has the TAIC material, promises Lillian's, and has an unsufficiently-modified Gientism. But there has been moderation.

Again, not so you'll ask them, for I'd rather you didn't, but I've not heard a word from Lillian/Fred, despite their promise to you to send me this material. It is as a yardstick that I tell you this.
