Dear Mike,

When we spoke last week you said you'd send me a set of your series after it was published, probably the end of this week. May I ask also for the fifth and following articles of the Rudy series? I have the first four.

I am writing on the Manchester book. You may perhaps recall that before the conflict became public I predicted what I considered inevitable. However, I do not think the significance is generally understood. If special permission is required to quote from the Post, how do I seek and get it?

You know my belief about the Manchester book and its potential. If you have any suggestions I'd welcome them.

I plan to make a few of the documents I have collected for WHITEWASH III: THE ARCHIVE public. One was released today. If you think the Post would be interested, I can supply Thermo-fax copies if you'd like. The one I gave the Frederick paper for today discloses a piece of the President's skull was found 25 feet south of his location at the time of the fatal shot and 29 hours after it by a student, not an investigator.
