

'Attempt to emasculate JFK book'

William Manchester, author of the controversial book *Death of a President*, says that Richard Goodwin, former White House aide, acting for Mrs. Jacqueline Kennedy, "tried to emasculate" extracts of the book printed in *Look* magazine.

"Dick Goodwin was made responsible by Jackie for everything that would be in the manuscript," Manchester asserts. "His editing of the book galley was fantastic."

"At one point nearly 50 per cent of the third instalment was edited. It would have been unprintable."

He was editing—largely for political reasons—material about Bobby Kennedy and Johnson.
