**Pearson Not Convincing**

Drew Pearson's pitch Jan. 12 that Vice President Lyndon Johnson opposed President Kennedy's trip to Texas won't convince many long-remembered readers of Dallas newspapers during 1963.

On April 23-24, 1963, both of the Dallas dailies featured front page stories on an interview LBJ held with local editors and politicians following his speech to a NASA convention at noon on the 23d.

The highlight of the interview was LBJ's urging to the city's political leaders to push for a visit to Dallas by President Kennedy — during the coming summer if possible, or sometime in 1963.
