He says (4th col, Newsweek, Post 1/23/67) not that the book is not anti-LBJ but that "The book is not pathologically anti-LBJ". He then says "I am distressed that there have been s so many anti-Johnson stroies attributed to the book. They are not true and they are not in the book at all. But I couldn't havoid reporting what he actually did".

Examples, from his public statements; tong; the Connaly under the window story, whole handling of the trip back, swearing in, where he lied to make an anti-LEJ scene on plane. The whole handling of the former JFK sides aides' attitudes, to make it seem they considered LEJ the assassin.
