Manchester's 3 Years of Tumult

William Manchester will give his account of his dealings with the Kennedy family over "The Death of a President," in Look magazine's April 4 issue, scheduled to appear on newsstands March 21.

In promotional material, Look says the author of what it calls the "most controversial" book of the 20th Century looks back over 36 months in his new article—26 months of writing and 10 months of "tumult" that followed.

Look says "William Manchester's Own Story" retraces and explains his relationships with Mrs. Jacqueline Kennedy and Sen. Robert F. Kennedy—"the early courtesies and friendship, the long period of indifference and the final stormy clashes."

The magazine published the serialized version of "The Death of a President" following settlement of Mrs. Kennedy's lawsuit to block publication.
