Arson Charged

DALLAS—The caretaker of the Texas Schoolbook Depository, the building from which Lee Harvey Oswald fired the shots that killed President John F. Kennedy, has been charged with arson in connection with last week's fire in the building.

Winfred Jack Anderson, 26, was arrested and placed in Dallas County Jail in lieu of \$10,000 bond.

Anderson was employed by Aubrey Mahyew, a Nashville, Tenn., businessman who purchased the 68-year-old building in 1970 in hope of turning it into a museum.

Last Thursday someone broke into the seven-story red brick building, spread eight one-gallon cans of gasoline across five upper floors and then set fire to the structure. The blaze was extinguished about a half hour later with minimal damage.
