I've finished checking the individual folders for Inside now that I have access to them, all fifteen ~~in~~ inches of them!- and I've made a list of the titles on them. I also have the original table of contents. I'll enclose them both. Now I must look for the earlier retyped chapters that were not in the original box. When I find them I'll gradually change this new box to what is ^{only} ~~try~~ retyped. I have six marked "final copy." About nine ~~to~~ retyped but not final or possibly not. And aside from seeking them and making a single file I'll be going over what I've just examined and will removing the roughs that were retyped to get some room in that box.

I've heard ~~nothing~~ from Carol Deck or from Bill Weichter about the law but this is a week I'll not be able to do anything about her anyway. Not only because I'm having more trouble moving around (even not falling) than I can recall but because today I have my ~~fix~~ quarterly cardiologist visit and tomorrow a dental appointment, getting the car to the dealership for repair they farm out on the emission-controls system, then getting a rental car and then having that to return late the same day of the next one.

I've gotten an appointment with a different orthopedic surgeon but the first open appointment is for the middle of next month.

To begin with there was some organization to Inside but then as I got into more the organization was changed, particularly because I had only the most limited access to the box. I started to break it into ^{parts} ~~parts~~ and did not continue that. It may well require, in addition to other touches, some reorganization of the sequence of the chapters

Separation into parts when there are more than 60 chapters is probably a good idea. So also should the chapter numbers be ~~either~~ changed ^{from} to Roman numbers.

and with the belated publication of NEVER AGAIN! some Gallen changes will be required.

If I can move around no worse than now and if I've not heard from Carol Deck I plan next week, weather not making it unwise, to get a local lawyer. As of last night she not called and no letter from her.

I'll add to this later and this afternoon, when I will not be going out with ink all over my fingers, I'll put the new ribbon on. But before joining Lil, who is now up, for coffee a coincidence that goes back to what I think I sent you on the early non-publishing history of Whitewash of which I'd been reminded. One of those British reporters I referred to, Louis Heren's Washington bureau assistant chief, remains a friend. He is no longer a reporter. He wrote the story part of which I used on the Photo WW back cover.

Sunday was his 49th wedding anniversary. He and his wife spent some of it with us. She, an anthropologist and a fine cook, brought the meal. It was he who made what I could not reach in the box accessible for me by removing it from atop the file cabinets.

One of today's errands was to return a small electric heater. My feet have little circulation and feel the cold fast. I could not find any plug-in heater that can be used on the battery after the car is running, plugged into the cigarette lighter receptacle, around here. Defrosters that give too little heat, yes, but but a heater. So I got an electric one thinking I'd let it run a few minutes before leaving with the car motor turning over. Only the instructions say not to have it within 3 feet or any upholstery. So I had to return it. I go into this because you and Dave are in colder climates and perhaps they are made and are available to either one of you. When you can ask an auto store will you please and if they have it, please let me know the cost and size. But only plug-in. I do not want it wired in permanently so in mild weather it can be removed.

We've had no really cold weather. Lowest about 25. But we'll be getting some before long and I have those three blood tests at 7 a.m. each week.

I'll be redoing the box contents as I find what I should have. Until then this can perhaps be a guide.

On the heater, I did get one I had to return. More common are those for vans, back seats, but they have to be wired in. That is what I was sold.

I've copied perhaps a bit more than I should have at one time. Because of the changed in numbering I identify these by title, The Case of the Faking of Assassination Film; Film-Flam; and Accrediting an Assassination Accessory.

At the moment I'm also a bit uneasy. This was going to be not an easy day for me although not long ago there would have been nothing particularly difficult about it. I was going to have to skip the physical therapy, what I can do of it now but what I

want much not to miss but go for the blood testing, the clotting time being a bit erratic, then drive to the other side of town to the auto dealership to leave the car for repair, then drive back past where I was on the other side of town for a dental appointment, all on an expressway, which I always shun to the degree possible. But at about 2 a.m. the predicted snow began to fall and I have to worry about the slightest bump. And the expressway driving is sometimes pretty wild. If on schedule I'd have to begin well before daylight and that I will not do today. So I'm a bit more uneasy and will have to wait and see what can be safe for me. That may give me time to do more copying.

As I copied this I noticed that I had an insertion separate with a paperclip. I copied it that way.

This is the original. I have a copy of each on file.

I want ahead with the schedule almost without event. I was a bit uneasy because of the weather but what seems to have made me unsteady was getting up from the reclining position in the dentist's chair. Even though we did that in stages. So I will not trust myself to do more of this today. I'll read and correct what I've done and have it to mail in the morning Priority Mail to you at the college because of the size of the package. I've copied through Ch. 38 and send you the originals.

I plan to continue with that and get it overwith.

Maryland has a living will provizion in law now only we could not get the forms! Got them today and we both plan to execute them. I do not want to be kept alive artificially if in a vegetative state. Besides, I'd never want to be burdened that way. She's had it hard enough And when I get shaken and unsteady as I am now it is much on my mind.
