I find this unethical on several grounds, one being that what VBS has already gone is diamy@rically opposite the interest of the defense.

However, I am showced at this kind of professional attitude and conduct and that you would do what could jeopardize a man's rights and the case. One of my purposes is to be certain the facts as reported to me are true, as they seem to be without reasonable question. Another is to let you know how I feel. Still another is to remind you of the protective order of the court.

If after all of this you are willing to do what I think you should have done to begin with, give the defense investigator a copy of thos prints, I would like one.
