SAC JENSEN, Memphis, at 8:30 a.m., 4/22/68, tele-phonically contacted the New Orleans Office and advised that JOHN McFERREN, a Negro of Summerville, Tenn., buys produce from Italians in Memphis and heard an Italian talking on the telephone "Kill the S.O.B. on the balcony and get the job done. You'll get your five thousand".

Interviews in Memphis reflects it was common talk among the produce prople there that they had no "love" for MARTIN LUTHER KING and made many disparaging remarks and were constantly "riding the niggers".

He requested that interviews be conducted with TONY LIBERTO, VINCENT LIBERTO, SALVATORE LIBERTO, and Mrs. EMILY LIBERTO, mother of FRANK CAMILLE LIBERTO; that a teletype be sent to the Bureau, Memphis, Birmingham and Atlanta with results of these interviews and appropriate 302s prepared on each individual.
