In response to the list of names of those reported arrested north of Lake Pontchartrain in 1963, the Archives has come up with only one that is close, not one of those - gave them. It is my recollection one is identical with a name on the bus manifest. If this is the case, they did not make name files of the manifest or they are holding out.

The attached nono pages of CD 825 are, however, fascinating. Here we have a man from a much better than average station in Cuban society and, it would seem, one who knew Mike McLanay well enough to get a post-Castro job from him. Having the same matronymic does not mean he is related to Soto Vasquez, but the possibility exists.

Then it turns out there is this connection with the camps, the McLanay brother having provided the property for the same depot.

Unless recollection is flawed, O'Connor, the filing agent, knew about the camps because he worked on the Fernando Hernandez bit.

Does anyone have the O'Connor 12/31/63 report, or is it one I've already used, referred to above?

These pages do not reflect (p 1, par 1) how the "remarks" indicated he "led the employee to believe" he "was acquainted with" (L), unless it was suggested after the fact.

Description is rather meager, with even weight omitted.
