SUBJECT: RELEASE OF MURKIN DOCUMENTS

PURPOSE:

To advise the Finance and Personnel Division of receipt of the attached check.

DETAILS:

On November 17, 1976, Mr. George McMillan telephonically contacted SA Tom Bresson and requested copies of the 443 pages of Murkin material which had reportedly been made available to the public. SA Bresson informed Mr. McMillan that he could obtain the Murkin documents at FBI Headquarters. Mr. McMillan made an appointment to have these documents released to his associate, Mr. Stuart Johnson, at 2 o'clock on November 19, 1976. Mr. Johnson appeared at FBI Headquarters on the afternoon of November 19, 1976. The 443 pages of Murkin material were released to Mr. Johnson for which he presented Mr. McMillan's check in the amount of \$44.30 in payment of these documents.
