Quick Memo

Thanks for calling my attention to the listing for Kellerman on page 123 of the Subject Index. There is only one error, and it is a printing error (the editor at Scarecrow had warned me that some errors inevitably creep in after pages are proofed).

The first citation under Kellerman should be "CE 768 (p 607)" not "CE 968 (p 607)." The page numbers in parentheses may refer to the page of the volume, or to the page of the exhibit (as explained in the Subject Index, page 105). In this case, it is the page of the volume.

I hope that clears it up for you. It takes a little getting used-to, but I believe that in many instances use of the Index can save considerable time--I even use it myself!
