Mexico Student Leader Charged

MEXICO CITY (AP) — The federal attorney general's office announced Wednesday the arraignment of a student leader associated with an Argentine-founded Trotskyite group and involved in the bloody student riots last year.

The office said charges against Jose Natividad Francisco Colmenares, 23, included sedition, inciting to rebellion and other illegal acts which were not specified.

The office said, in a statement, that Colmenares "admitted his active role in the student agitation which broke out S. July 26, 1968, as a member of the strike committee of the National University of Mexico's school of economics and a member of the Trotskyite group headed in Mexico by Argentine nationals Oscar Jose Fernandez Bruno and Adolfo Atilio Malvagni, Gylly, both on trial."

Charges against the two Argentines were not specified, but it was learned they were arrested in 1966.
