If I did not write to tell you that the WWs came and to tahnk you, please forgive me. This has been in some ways the strangest of my life and most days I have been wearier than I can recall and with no real exertion to cause it. I'd have gone to the emergency room this early morning if I did not worry about il being by herself. She can't walk well or much but she is back in physical therapy and is doing remarkably well in it

Tuesday a friend drove us to Johns Hopkins for my regular consultation with my cardiologist there. That gave me some good exercies, weeling "il in a wheel chair because she can't walk much safely. Not because he detected any need but just to Keep closer to it the cardiologist ordered chest X-rays (OK) and a 24-hgur Holter monitor, which is like a walking EKG. I returned it Priority Mail mail Wednesday so if anything showed on that I should have heard from him. But since then the slightest exertion has me feeling completely worn out and weak. The little walking I did this morning did that. As it did yesterday. Both mornings I took a nap when home but they were no pickup.

I think that tomorrow I'll do no walking and see if that makes a difference or very little if Lil wants anything.

I did finish reading and correcting the fine job Clay did in Fretyping WHORING WITH HISTORY: HOW THE GERALD POSNERS PROTECT THE KING ASSASSINS and I've sent it with corrections back to him. I had only an epilogue to do for what I've not yet titled, that disgrace by Twyman that amounts to bis title, Bloody Treason

Looking at the box of WWs I've not yet put on the shelves I saw that we are again don's to eight Oswald in New Orleans but slowly as they are selling, that is no crisis. But I hope the time womes when you get a break in time and can get some more of them started.

There is always a scandal the papers are Not touching with the ARRB's failure to issue any report on the autopsy or to say a word about the abvious perjury they have in it but right now I'm too weary to think of fighting city hall again now.

I'm going to knock off and take in a ball game on TV. Maybe it will get these workies off my mind.
