I do not think the swivel would be a benefit. It is easy enough to move the whole thing when it is on crazy wheels.

The actual space between my desk and the window is but 34". So I have to move the whole thing to get in or out.

In fact, the swivel might make a problem.

It is because there is so little space that I think the table ^{and base} should not be any larger than ^{they are} it now is.

I do not think the adjustment should go to anywhere near 15". It should be the present height at the maximum and perhaps ^a six or more ^{of} settings that are lower.

If a bolt were used instead of a pin and had a wing nut it would I think be better for me. And the chain is not a good idea. My legs will hit it and that will tear the supports I have to wear.

The tilt would not help and might be a disadvantage. Besides being more work.
