If this is some days getting mailed we are about a third of the way into the blizzard that may for this area be the record-breaker. Can't tell the depth here because it is a light, dry powdery snow that also is blowing but the last I saw on TV about an hour ago was that ~~on~~ one side of us the depth is 10 inches and on the other side 9. The prediction is for ~~at~~ 30". I hate to think of what the lane will be like in the morning with the blowing that is visible. There can be large drifts in addition to that depth. and then as the roads are cleared the snow on the roads is thrown into the lanes. That can be an additional up to 15 feet of extra snow at the end of the lane.

And I'm due for a blood test in the morning to determine if the dosage of the anti-coagulant is OK!

I'll be lucky to have it Tuesday!

There will not be much thawing. The daytime temperature ~~is~~ is ten degrees.

With winds up to 35 mph.

I'm grateful it is a dry snow. The wet snows are what take the lines down.
