✓ Left Valdosta, Ga. July 8, 1963 & went

to Dallas, Texas &

called on Mr. Dan Smoot.

Mr. Smoot was approached
as a running mate with

J. Strom Thurmond, Senator
from South Carolina. Mr.

Smoot declined the Vice Presi-
dent spot and suggested that
I talk to Mr. Tom Anderson,
Editor of Farm + Ranch +
"Straight Talk".

On July 10th 1963, I talked
with Mr. Tom Anderson on
the phone in Nashville, Tenn.
about 4:40 P.M. Mr. Anderson
will accept the "second spot"
(V.P.) if we can show
him enough support.

Went on to see Mr. Wordy Kerns,
in St. Albans, W. Va. on
July 11th, 1963. Left there and visited
Mr. Joe Lightbourn in Jane Linn, W. Va.
on July 12th, 1963.

2
July 13, 1963
Left Mr. Lightburn's + went
on to Wallingford, Pa. + called
on Miss Olga Butterworth. After
a pleasant visit with Miss Olga
Butterworth + her sister + a
telephone conversation with Col.
Curtis B. Ball, I drove to
Delaware.

In Milford, Del. I visited
with Mr. + Mrs. E. E. James.
Sunday, July 14th, 1963. I stayed
in Dover, Del.

Monday morning I stopped in
Baltimore, Md. - July 15, 1963. Then
I drove to Atlanta, Ga.

On Tuesday night, July 16th, 1963
I taped Gov. Ross Barnett's
address at the Dirker-Plyco
Hotel. Over 3000 attended.

Returned home on July 17th
1963 early in the morning, about
11:30 A.M.

3// On Sunday morning July 21, 1963
about 5:30 I left for St.
Albans, W. Va. to visit with
Mr. Woody Hens + work at
a Fair there with Mr. Joe
Lightburn. I stayed there 3
days + then left on Wednesday
night for Louisville, Ky.

I called on Mr. Grubbs
and hear his promise that he +
his organization will go along with
J. Strom Thurmond for President
working through the Constitution
Party. July 25, 1963.

After 3 or 4 hours visit with
Mr. Grubbs I started for N.
Dakota. I visited with Mr.
George Conity at Blue Grass,
N. Dakota (P.O. at New Salem)

Mr. Conity joined with the
Constitution Party movement to
back J. Strom Thurmond for
President. - July 27, 1963

After leaving Mr. Conity
I started West. Kept driving

in N. Dakota, Montana, Wyo.
Idaho & Utah. I reached
Provo, Utah Monday July 29th 1963.
Had the "Red Carpet" rolled out for
me & had a newspaper interview
with my picture in the Herald
newspaper - Provo, Utah. Just planted
a few "seeds" about J. Ottem
Thurmond for President & it
was received very well.

Left Provo & started back
East. Went to Louisville, Ky. &
talked with Mr. Swales on the
telephone & then went on to St.
Albans & to see Mr. Joe Lightburn in
Jane Lew. Left Jane Lew & drove
home reaching Valdosta on
Sunday morning Aug. 4, 1963.

5/ On Aug. 13th 1963 I left
Valdosta about 4:30 A.M. for
Augusta, Ga. to see Mr. Roy
Harris. He was out so I drove
to Bloomingdale, Ga. to see Mr.
Charlie Mattox. He is willing to
go along with Strom Thurmond
for President provided Mr.
Thurmond will commit him-
self with regards to accepting a
"draft" for President.

Left Mr. Mattox & returned to
Augusta, Ga. where I saw Mr.
Roy Harris for an hour. He
& the States Rights Party of Ga.
will go along with the Constitution
Party with Strom Thurmond
for President. If Mr. Harris
cannot attend the meeting in
Indianapolis, Ind. in October
he will try + get Carter Pittman
to go.

Left Augusta & returned to
Valdosta, Ga.

6// Saturday, Aug. 24, 1963 went
to Savannah, Ga. at the old
Oglethorpe Race Track where
a KKK meeting was held.
Mr. Charlie Macclat was in
charge. Met Mr. James R.
Venable there. I made two
appearances at the "mick" +
spoke briefly. Still the show.
The KKK is now going
along with Senator J. Strom
Thurmond for President.

Saturday - Aug. 31, 1963
went to Stone Mountain to
a KKK meeting where I
used my big American flag
to "duck" the speaker's
stand. Met many friends
but did not speak. 41
states + some foreign countries
were represented. Several
thousand people were present.
State patrol kept me away
by blocking the roads. James Venable
in charge.

~~Left Mr. Craig~~

7/ Saturday - Sept. 7, 1963.
Went to Fitzgerald to a
KKKK meeting. I spoke to
some 3000 over the radio. Albert
Meyers + Mr. Campbell were there.
Albert spoke. Calvin Craig was
in charge.

Friday - Sept. 13, 1963. - I left
Valdosta in the VW at 2:15 AM for
Atlanta. Missed seeing Calvin Craig
early. Called on G. Sels Aiken
& he was not in. Left a verbal
invitation for him to attend the
Convention of the Constitution Party
in Indianapolis, Ind., Oct. 18,
19* 20. Called on Lee M^o Cloud
of 241 West Minister Drive + spent
most of the day with him. Had
lunch with him + his wife.
Left + went to Marietta to the
VW place. Bryan went on to
Chattanooga I called on Mr.

Jack Brown, He and his
group are for Gov. Wallace
but will support Thurmond
if necessary. Left Mr. Brown
& went to Dalton, Ga. & saw
Rev. Henry G. White. Talked
with him before he went to
work & then spent the night
with his family. Had breakfast
with them & drove back to
Atlanta. Called on Lee M. - Lord
again & then contacted Mr.
Calvin Craig about 5:00 PM
Said Craig says P-A-12 ~~volt~~
volt system. He suggested
that I go see Robert Shelton
of ~~Falabassa~~ Tuskegee
Va. Met 3 other men in his
office from Texas, La. & Ark.
Shelton will go along with any
man that can get the vote
& favors Gov. Wallace. Wallace
will enter primaries in Maryland
& Indiana in 1964 as a trial balloon.
Returned to Valdosta. (over)

Wednesday - Sept. 18, 1963

Left Valdosta in the VW + drove to Conway, S.C. Failed to see the man I was looking for but met a man by the name of Dew, who operates a grocery store about 2 miles from Conway. He donated \$5.00 to me for my efforts.

Left Conway, S.C. + drove to Janesville to see Mr. Joe Lightburn. After a visit with Mr. Lightburn I went to St. Albans where I saw Mr. Woody Kerns. Had dinner + then left for Louisville, Ky. where I saw Mr. Grubbs about 10:30 at night - Friday - Sept. 20th. (I left 10 tape by Dr. Swift with Mr. Kerns.) I left Louisville, Ky. for Chicago, Ill.

I attended the meeting of "We The People" at the Sheraton - Chicago - Saturday Sept. 21st. Feel like I did a lot ^{of good} ~~different~~ different ones to attend our Constitution Party meeting in Indianapolis, Ind., Oct. 18-19 + 20th.

Left Chicago + drove West. Arrived at Provo, Utah Tuesday morning where I picked up a new Norelco portable tape recorder. Also had an interview with

Wednesday - Sept. 25, 1963

Stayed in Provo ~~the~~ Tuesday night & Wednesday morning. Tried to see Mayor J. Bracken Lee, Mayor of Salt Lake City, Utah, former Governor of Utah. He was in a Board meeting & had the files so I did not see him. Went next to the Administration Building of the Latter Day Saints & saw Eric Tapp Benson for a brief 2 minutes. Invited him to the Constitution Party meeting in Indianapolis, Ind., Oct 18, 19 & 20th. He did not think he could attend. Talked with Elder or Bishop Wright & feel like I influenced him enough to have them send a Representative or two to the Constitution Party meeting.

mechanics, mostly Spanish) were interested.

Saturday - Sept. 28, 1963 -

Called on Mr. Jack Gladden of the Fort Worth Press
& he said he would put an article in his paper

Sunday, Sept. 29, 1963

Drove to Shreveport, La. & about noon
I saw Mr. Charles ^{W.C.} Phillip, a Reporter
on the Shreveport Journal. In his Saturday
paper he had an article about the Constitution.

12/ Sunday - Sept. 29, 1963 - Continued.

Party on the first page of the second section. Ike expects to attend the Party meeting in Indianapolis, Ind.

Went to Drown to Alexandria, La. & saw Mr. E. Otis Edgerton, Jr. at 1623 Harvard, his home. We had a good talk & he is going to get different ones to attend the Party meeting. Left there for New Orleans, La.

Monday - Sept. 30, 1963.

Drown to New Orleans where I saw Mr. George W. Healy III an Attorney (young). He might attend the meeting in Indianapolis, Ind. Called on Mr. Fernand F. Willey III another young Attorney. He said he would try & contact some others to attend our meeting.

Failed to see Judge Sanchez J. Perez but left an invitation & literature with his secretary. Left New Orleans for Summit, Miss. where I saw Mrs. Mary Cain for about 5 or 6 minutes. She was very busy. She will be unable to attend our meeting in Indianapolis.

13/ Monday - Sept 30, 1963 Continued

Left Summit + drove to Jackson, Miss. Saw a large, heavy set ~~man~~ man at the headquarters of the Citizens Councils. They do not take an actual part in politics + will not send anyone to the meeting in Indianapolis, Ind.

Tuesday - Oct. 1, 1963

Drove to Tuscaloosa, Ala. + tried to see Robert Hillton but never did see him. Drove on to Montgomery, Ala. where I saw Mr. Chester Robinson of 3500 Mobile Highway, Montgomery, Ala. Then I drove out to Wetumpka, Ala. to see Admiral Cronin.
