Round-up of
Rightist Groups

Left Valdosta, Ga. ^{July 8, 1963} & went
to Dallas, Texas &
called on Mr. Dan Smoot.
Mr. Smoot was approached
as a running mate with
J. Strom Thurmond, Senator
from South Carolina. Mr.
Smoot declined the Vice Presi-
dent spot and suggested that
I talk to Mr. Tom Anderson,
Editor of Farm + Ranch &
"Straight Talk".

On July 10th 1963 . I talked
with Mr. Tom Anderson on
the phone in Nashville, Tenn.
about 4:40 P.M. Mr. Anderson
will accept the "second spot"
(V.P) if we can show
him enough support.

Went on to see Mr. Woody Korns,
in St. Albans, W. Va. on
July 11th, 1963. Left there and visited
Mr. Joe Lightburn in Jane Lew, W. Va.
on July 12th, 1963.

~~2//~~ July 13, 1963 Left Mr. Lightburn's + went
on to Wallingford, Pa. + called
on Miss Olga Butterworth. After
a pleasant visit with Miss Olga
Butterworth + her sister + a
telephone conversation with Col.
Curtis B. Dall, I drove to
Delaware.

On Wilford, Del. I visited
with Mr. + Mrs. E. C. James.
Sunday, July 14th, 1963, I stayed
in Dover, Del.

Monday morning I stopped in
Baltimore, Md. - July 15, 1963. Then
I drove to Macon, Ga.

On Tuesday night, July 16th, 1963
I taped Gov. Ross Barnett's
address at the Driskill Plaza
Hotel. Over 3000 attended.

Returned home on July 19th
1963 early in the morning, about
11:30 A.M.

3// On Sunday morning July 21, 1963
about 5:30 I left for St.
Albans, W. Va. to visit with
Mr. Worthy Fergus + work at
a Fair there with Mr. Joe
Lightburn. I stayed there 3
days + then left on Wednesday
night for Louisville, Ky.

I called on Mr. Grubbs
and have his promise that he +
his organization will go along with
J. Strom Thurmond for President
working through the Constitution
Party. July 25, 1963.

After 3 or 4 hours visit with
Mr. Grubbs I started for N.
Dakota. I visited with Mr.
George Conitz at Blue Grass,
N. Dakota (P.O. at New Salem)

Mr. Conitz joined with the
Constitution Party movement to
back J. Strom Thurmond for
President. - July 27, 1963

After leaving Mr. Conitz
I start West. kept driving

in N. Dakota, Montana, Wyo.

Idaho & Utah. I reached

Provo, Utah Monday July 29th 1963.

Had the "Red Carpet" rolled out for
me & had a newspaper interview
with my picture in the Herald
newspaper - Provo, Utah. Just planted

a few "seeds" about J. Strom
Thurmond for President & it
was received very well.

Left Provo & started back
East. Went to Louisville, Ky. &
talked with Mr. Grubbs on the
telephone & then went on to St.
Albans & to see Mr. Joe Lightburn in
Lane Lwo. Left Lane Lwo & drove
home reaching Valdosta on
Sunday morning Aug. 4, 1963.

5/ On Aug. 13th 1963 I left
Valdosta about 4:30 A.M. for
Augusta, Ga. to see Mr. Roy
Harris. He was out so I drove
to Bloomingdale, Ga. to see Mr.
Charlie Mattox. He is willing to
go along with Strom Thurmond
for President provided Mr.
Thurmond will commit his
self with regards to accepting a
"Draft" for President.

Left Mr. Mattox & returned to
Augusta - Ga. where I saw Mr.
Roy Harris for over an hour. He
& the States Rights Party of Ga.
will go along with the Constitutional
Party with Strom Thurmond
for President. If Mr. Harris
cannot attend the meeting in
Indiana polis, Ind. in October
he will try & get Carter Pittman
to go.

Left Augusta & returned to
Valdosta, Ga.

6// Saturday, Aug. 24, 1963 went
to Savannah, Ga. at the old
Oglethorpe Race Track where
a KKKKK meeting was held.
Mr. Charlie Macdole was in
charge. Met Mr. James R.
Venable there. Spoke two
appearances at the "mick" &
spoke briefly. At the show.
The KKKKK is now going ~~on~~
along with Senator J. Strom
Thurmond for President.

Saturday - Aug. 31, 1963
went to Stone Mountain to
a KKKKK meeting where I
used my big American flag
to "deck" the speakers
stand. Met many friends
but did not speak. 41
states + some foreign countries
were represented. Several
thousand people were present.
State patrol kept many away
by blocking the roads. James Venable
in charge.

7/ Saturday Sept. 7, 1963.
went to Fitzgerald to a
KKKK meeting. I spoke to
some 300 on the road. Albert
Myers & W. Campbell were there.
Albert spoke. Calvin Craig was
in charge.

Friday - Sept. 13, 1963. - I left
Valdosta in the VW at 2:15 AM for
Atlanta. Missed seeing Calvin Craig
early. Called on G. Subs Aiken
& he was not in. Left a verbal
invitation for him to attend the
Convention of the Constitution Party
in Indianapolis, Ind., Oct. 18,
19 & 20. Called on Lee McCloud
of 241 West Minister Drive & spent
most of the day with him. Had
lunch with him & his wife.
Left & went to Marietta to the
VW place. ~~Began~~ Went on to
Chattanooga & called on Mr.

8 Jack Brown, He and his group are for Gov. Wallace but will support Thurmond if necessary. Left Mr. Brown & went to Dalton, Ga. & saw Rev. Henry G. White. Talked with him before he went to work & then spent the night with his family. Had breakfast with them & drove back to Atlanta. Called on Lee McCloud again & then contacted Mr. Calvin Craig about 5:00 PM said Craig my P-A-12 volt volk system. He suggested that I go see Robert Shelton of ~~Fatigues~~ Truskaloosa Ala. Met 3 other men in his office from Tex as, La. & Ark. Shelton will go along with any man ~~that~~ can get the vote & favors Gov. Wallace. Wallace will enter primaries in Maryland & Indiana in 1964 as a trial balloon. Returned to Valdosta. (over)

Had dinner + then left for Louisville, Ky. where I saw Mr. Grubbs about 10:30 at night - Friday - Sept. 20th. (I left 10 tape by Dr. Swift with Mr. Kerns.) I left Louisville, Ky. for Chicago, Ill.

I attended the meeting of "We The People" at the Sharaton - Chicago - Saturday Sept. 21st. Feel like I did a lot of good inviting different ones to attend our Constitution Party meeting in Indianapolis, Ind., Oct. 18-19 + 20th.

Left Chicago + drove West. Arrived at Provo, Utah Tuesday morning where I picked up a new Norelco portable tape recorder. Also had an interview with

Wednesday - Sept. 25, 1963.

Stayed in Provo ~~on~~ Tuesday night & Wednesday morning tried to see Mayor J. Bracken Lee, Mayor of Salt Lake City, Utah, former Governor of Utah. He was in a Board meeting & had the file so I did not see him. Went next to the Administrator Building of the Latter Day Saints & saw Ezra Taft Benson for a brief 2 minutes. Invited him to the Constitution Party meeting in Deseretaria polyg. Ind., Oct 16, 1963. He did not think he could attend. Talked with Elder or Bishop Wright & feel like I influenced him enough to have them send a Representative or two to the Constitution Party meeting.

Drove on to Montgomery, Ala. where I saw Mr. Chester Robinson of 3500 Mobile Highway, Montgomery, Ala. Then I drove out to Wetumpka, Ala. to see Admiral Crommelin.
