

THE MINUTEMEN PLEDGE

To the restoration of our Constitutional Republic, to the defense of individual freedom, and to the preservation of our American Heritage, we pledge our lives, our fortunes, and our sacred honor.

Fully realizing the need for teamwork and undying loyalty to the cause of freedom and the Minutemen Organization, I do solemnly swear to work with all my strength and courage for a free America.

I shall perform without objection all the instructions of the Organization which may be entrusted to me and I shall not bring any objection, however difficult and dangerous these may be. I shall always perform my duties to the very best of my abilities. I shall stick to my duties despite danger and hardship until I am honorably relieved by my Leader.*

I shall never reveal to anyone any secret of the Minutemen Organization including the names of my Leaders and fellow members, even if I am caught and tortured. I shall not reveal any of the instructions which may be given me even to my fellow members.

If I disobey this solemn oath, may Almighty God, the author of Liberty for which we fight, reward me swiftly with the punishment due me as a traitor and may eternal contempt cover me.

Until my socialist enemies are defeated, I shall gladly make any sacrifice for liberty; I shall never surrender!

Keep this Pledge handy, memorize it, and reflect upon it regularly.
