Minuteman Depugh To Be Taken to Mo.

ALBUQUERQUE N.M., July 16 (UPI)—The founder of the anti-Communist Minuteman organization and his top side, arrested by FBI agents in southern New Mexico last week, were ordered today to be returned to Kansas City, purchase of arms to maintain what their organization called "the last line of defense against communism."

U.S. Commissioner Robert McCoy ordered Robert Boliver Depugh, 47, and Walter Peyson, 27, to the custody of the U.S. marshal for the transfer. Depugh was to begin serving a one-year sentence on a Fed-feral firesyms conviction in Missouri.

Peyson's return was based on a bench warrant for his arrest for failure to appear for turn.
