This memorandum further disclosed that according to Dallas records CHANEY has never been interviewed by the Bureau. Moreover, there was no La indication that CHANEY was interviewed or testified before the Warren Commission. This information was furnished by telecopier to Deputy Associate Director JAMES B. ADAMS, at 5:15 PM, 9/4/75. At 3:20 PM, 9/5/75, Deputy Associate Director THOMAS JENKINS advised that after consultation with the Director on this date, Dallas Office should be instructed to interview CHANEY immediately. MR. JENKINS also indicated that a review of Bureau records disclosed possibility that there were also possibly two other officers who have never been interviewed. I mentioned to MR.
