Told of Killing

LONDON, Nov. 1 (AP)—A self-styled Hell's Angel stabbed a man to death then wrote a song about it and boasted to his friends about the nighttime slaying, a British court was told today. But, the jury was told, no one believed 18-year-old factory worker William Devanney.

Devanney and another youth, Peter Stimson, 18, have pleaded innocent to the murder of Charles Hedges, also 18, last June.

Prosecuting attorney John Matthew claimed that Devanney had earlier admitted stabbing Hedges in a park and told police he wanted to be hanged. Hell's Angels is a motorcycle gang in the United States. There is a similar group in Britain.
