On November 23, 1963, Detective SIMS, Homicide and  
Robbery Division, Dallas Police Department, advised he had received  
information from one J. C. NURDOCK, Grand Prairie, Texas, police  
officer, that one LARRY THORNLEY, white male, age 24, address  
1824 Dauphine, New Orleans, Louisiana, was a close friend of  
OSWALD and served with him in the U. S. Marines at the El Toro,  
California, Marine Base. NURDOCK alleged that THORNLEY is presently  
a waiter in New Orleans and has recently been in Old Mexico and  
California with OSWALD.
