Dear Mr. Noble,

It is beyond my physical capacity to make xeroxes of the documents I publish in facsimile. They are exactly as I obtained them from the government.

I don't know which book you refer to so I include a list of them in case there are others you do not have that you may want. Post Mortem^e has close to 200 pages of the reproduction of such documents.

The January 27 transcript will cost you about three times what the book sells for. (There is one of 1/22 in Post Mortem.)

There is no transcript of 9/18/64. It was a fake. I used the first two pages only. I think there were six. I have phlebitis and can't check the file now.

The point was that Senator Russell's doubts were not recorded, which is what angered him.

However, if you want xeroxes, you can get them from the National Archives and Records Service by identifying them as I have identified them in the book. The charge is 15¢ a page with a minimum of \$2.00. There are close to 100 pages in the 1/27 one.

Please excuse my haste and errors. I'm not well and not able to keep up with my work.
