They have their special variant of what Redditt told Les, unfactual, as usual. If Egdditt said it it would be incompetended and I'd be surprised. It really is vintage Lane, not what Igd expect for from Reditt, who impressed me as a solid man, conservative.

However, we now have NBC, this long after my putting them on notice and having the certified receipt back, claiming to have done my work.

Leg' work, of course, is his own. But he interviewed no witness I did not tell him to and he began with my Cointelpro proofs. I still have the tage of this he listened to as his beginning point on that. Redditt is one I urged on him from what my own work had told me. I did not know of the real reason for the yanking of Redditt, that is, the one they gave him, but I did know of his being withdrawn. I do not know if it is in Frame-Up. I gave Les copies of all those notes, referred to in Frame-Up.

All of this is in the manuscript, homestly not with the fakery visited upon the Congress, as of before April.

So I am suggesting that if he have the Laffines or any other story prior to the next status call in 1996 it can be the most powerful kind of argument in it.
