Dear Mr. Weisberg:

In your letter to me of March 23, and in earlier letters and discussions, you have requested a copy of the memorandum of transfer referred to in the Report of the 1968 Panel Review of Photographs, X-ray Films, Documents and Other Evidence Pertaining to the Fatal Wounding of President John F. Kennedy on November 22, 1963, in Dallas, Texas. Although left at the Archives building for safekeeping, that memorandum is a private paper which is not the property of the United States. It belongs to the Kennedy family, and requests for permission to see it should be made to Honorable Burke Marshall, Old Orchard Road, Armonk, New York 10504. For your information, I understand that the black and white and color negatives referred to in the 1968 Panel Review are the same negatives listed in Appendix B in the Kennedy deed of gift of October 29, 1966, a copy of which you have.
