In the past I have asked for access to all of the raw materials of the so-called Clark panel, which made a study of autopsy-materials in the assassination of President John F. Kennedy and made a report to the then Attorney General.

This report was made public and was used in a court proceeding in which the National Archives was involved.

I have not been given access to all of these raw materials.

This letter is my appeal from that refusal.

In the event you also refuse me, I ask that you promptly forward this appeal through any remaining channels of appeal that may exist.

Dr. Rhoads can supply you with copies of the relevant correspondence if he has not already done so.
