NEW YORK (UPI) -- THE FIRST NONGOVERNMENT MEDICAL EXPERT TO EXAMINE THE X-RAYS AND PHOTOGRAPHS OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY AFTER HIS ASSASSINATION SAID SUNDAY HE IS CONVINCED LEE #ARVEY OSWALD ALONE FIRED THE FATAL SHOTS.

PHYSICIANS AND SURGEONS SAID HIS EXAMINATION OF THE PATHOLOGICAL EVIDENCE "ELIMINATES ANY DOUBT COMPLETELY" ABOUT THE FINDINGS OF THE MARREM COMMISSION, WHICH CONTUCTED THE OFFICIAL INVESTIGATION OF THE ASSASSINATION.

THE COMMISSION FOUND THAT MENNEDY WAS MILLED NOV. 22; 1963

IN DALLAS BY TWO SHOTS OSWALD FIRED FROM THE TEXAS BOOK

DEPOSITORY AS THE PRESIDENT'S MOTORCAGE PASSED. THE COMMISSION

WAS HEATED BY EARL WARREN, THEN THE CHIEF JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME
COURT.

"I HAD DOUBTS ABOUT CERTAIN POINTS OF THE COMMISSION REPORT BEFORE I GOT TO SEE THE X-RAYS, BUT DASED ON WHAT I SAW THEY HAVE BEEN DISPELLED," LATTINER TOLD A NEWS COMPERENCE.

. LAGITATER'S SPECIALTY IS URGLOST. BUT AS ALL ARMY IDETER BUNITUS UDDIED WAR AS HE MAD EXPENSIVE EXPERIENCE TREATING DUBLET WOUNTS. SLUCE THEM HE HAS MADE A STUDY OF ASSASSINATIONS BY GUISHOTS AND MAS LECTURED AND WRITTEN ABOUT THE KEMMEDY ASSASSINATION.

LATTIMER WAS THE FIRST NONGOVERNMENT EXPERT PERMITTED TO SEE THE 65 N-RAYS, COLOR TRANSPARENCIES AND BLACK-AND-WHITE PHOTOGRAPHS TAKEN AT THE KENNELY AUTOPSY. THEY ARE IN THE NATIONAL ARCHIVES IN WASHINGTON, D.C.

ME BAID THE MOUND THAT DESTROYED MOST OF THE RIGHT SIDE OF MENNELY'S BRAIN WAS "MORRIBLE" AND THE PICTURES SHOULD MEVER BE MADE PUBLIC.

HE DISCUSSED AT LENGTH THE OTHER BULLET THAT PASSED THROUGH HENNELY'S MECK. SKETCHES OF THE PATH OF THIS BULLET PUBLISHED BY THE COMMISSION SHOWED ITS TRAJECTORY AS NEARLY LEVEL.

DUT THE SMETCHES WERE MADE WITHOUT THE COMMISSION OFFICIALS OR STAFF MEMBERS HAVING ACCESS TO THE AUTOPSY K-RAYS OR PHOTOGRAPHS BECAUSE OF THE WISHES OF THE KENNEDY FAMILY. LATTIMER SAID THE COMMISSION WOULD HAVE MADE A STRONGER CASE IF THOSE WHO PREPARED THE FINAL REPORT HAD SEEN THE ITEMS.

SOME CRITICS OF THE WARREN REPORT CONTEND THAT THIS
BULLET WAS FIRED FROM A GRASSY KNOLL IN FRONT OF THE CAR WHILE
THE BRAIN WOUND WAS INFLIECTED FROM BEHIND, SO THERE MUST HAVE
BEEN TWO ABSASSINS.

LATTIMER SAID, "IF ANYONE WERE TO HAVE SHOT HIM FROM THE FROMT, THEY WOULD HAVE TO BE SQUATTING ON THE FLOOR OF THE CAR IN FROMT OF HIM."

CRITICS ALSO HAVE SAID THE PRESIDENT WAS HIT IN THE NECK BY TWO BULLETS, ONE FROM THE FRONT AND THE OTHER FROM THE BACK.

LATTINER SAID THE K-RAYS SHOW DEFINITELY THAT ONLY ONE
BULLET PASSED THROUGH THE NECK, AND THE PICTURES PROVE IT ENTERED
THE BACK OF THE NECK AND EMERGED THROUGH THE THROAT. THE COMMISSION
DECIDED THAT THE SAME BULLET WOUNDED TEXAS GOV. JOHN B.
CONNALLY, NOW TREASURY SECRETARY, WHO WAS SITTING ON A JUMP
SEAT IN FRONT OF KENNEDY.

LATTIMER'S RESEARCH ON THE ASSASSINATION LED TO A SERIES OF ARTICLES FOR MEDICAL JOURNALS ON EXPERIMENTS HE MADE WITH A WEAPON SIMILAR TO THE SCOPE-SIGHTED MANNLICHER-CARCANO CARBINE FOUND IN THE TEXAS BOOK DEPOSITORY.

THE EXPERIMENTS SHOWED THE RIFLE COULD PUT A BULLET THROUGH
47 INCHES OF PINE WOOD. THUS THE BULLET THAT WENT THROUGH
KENNEDY'S NECK WOULD HAVE BEEN POWERFUL ENOUGH TO WOUND HIM AND
CONNALLY.

THE X-RAYS AND PICTURES WERE PLACED IN THE NATIONAL ARCHIVES
IN OCTOBER, 1966, BY ROBERT F. KENNEDY, THEN U.S. ATTORNEY
GENERAL, WITH INSTRUCTIONS THAT ONLY CERTAIN GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS
WERE TO SEE THEM FOR FIVE YEARS.

MOU THEY MAY BE VIEWED BY "RECOGNIZED EXPERTS IN THE FIELD OF PATHOLOGY OR RELATED AREAS OF SCIENCE OR TECHNOLOGY," SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF DEPUTY YALE LAW DEAN BURKE MARSHALL AS A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE KENNEDY FAMILY.
