

Attachments to Archives (Deutch) 12/6/76 enb1975 releases EM 12/9/76

State's letter of 1/7/76 says list 2 still under review. Not provided here.

Kelley's 4/7/76 letter refers to Lane's request. The attached list accounts for the documents relating to him

CIA's (Gene Wilson) 1/26/76 letter has an FBI, not CIA inventory attached. The CIA's list is in the letter. The list consists of numbered Commission documents only.

FBI's 12/31/75 letter says there are quite a few referred to other agencies, etc.

But it is now a year and a half since they review began if these have not been processed yet.

From the letters and other evidence these are not complete lists or correspondence relating to all the records to have been reviewed. For example, the CIA withheld some staff papers and released others but these are not in its letter.

The total number of released pages to which Kelley refers seems to coincide with the number for which the Archives charged me. If so this means I did not receive all released pages. The correspondence and the check will reflect the number of pages.

The lists are in tabular form and do contain some information not in the earlier Commission list. I did not read them word for word but I did notice that a deBrusys document was referred to a foreign country. Unusual.
