

Dear Bill, Here is the holographic Earlene Roberts affidavit to the Secret Service about which I phoned you yesterday or the day before. They wrote it out, she signed it. Normal for the ~~is~~ feds. Also normal is omission of what is not of immediate interest to them. You will find this is their typed report a page of which I enclose. It also is in what I've just received, the CIA's copies of these Secret Service records. They include in their report what they omitted from her statement that he was waiting for the bus. They also omit from the report what I told you: the bus goes the wrong way. However it then turns around and goes to the theater. But this combined with the Hoover letter to Rowley I read to you make it solid: Oswald Could Not have Killed J.D. Tippit. I'll try to remember to get a new typewriter ribbon. Best, HW 4/20/77
